# THINGS YOU MAY NEED TO CONSIDER-

## SECURE PROPERTY

Your property, buildings or possessions may need to be secured after a fire. This may include temporary board up of windows, roofs or doorways, etc. or establishing protection for you and others from exposure situations relative to the conditions that may exist afterward.

## CONTACT INSURANCE CO.

Your insurance provider should be contacted as soon as possible after a fire to begin a process of restoration. Normally, the insurance company will have an emergency number for its claims department or you may initiate contact through your insurance agent. Inform your insurance company that it must contact our Fire Prevention Division before investigating the scene.

## TEMPORARY RELOCATION

Your insurance provider should be able to assist you with a temporary housing, if needed. Often, relatives or friends will help with these needs. If you need further assistance for emergency shelter, the Fire Department will help direct you.

## INVENTORY OF POSSESSIONS

An inventory of your possessions will assist you in your recovery process in the event of a fire. Hopefully, a copy is available in a safe location off of the premises, i.e. a safe deposit box. If not, you will need to establish a list of items you may have lost due to the fire.

## RED TAGS

Red tags may be placed upon heating systems, electrical systems, water systems, fire suppression systems, etc. by Fire Department personnel. For reasons of safety, it is a violation to use these systems until a repair has been completed to code and an inspection performed. Inspections can be requested through the New Baltimore Building Department at the following phone number: **(586) 725-2151 ex 105**

### ***IMPORTANT...***

***Michigan Law prohibits interference with fire personnel in the performance of their duty, including fire suppression and/or fire investigation activities. You will be notified by Fire Department Officials when you may re-enter your property after a fire has occurred.***

**YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH CONTACT PHONE # WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED. THIS # MAY BE A WORK, CELL OR FAMILY MEMBER'S PHONE.**

**YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH AN INSURANCE POLICY NUMBER AND A CONTACT NAME AND NUMBER FOR YOUR INSURANCE.**

## **Fire Reports**

Copies of fire incident reports are usually made available for a fee within a few days after a fire occurs and may be obtained through the City Clerks office, 36535 Green Street, during normal business hours Monday through Friday 8:00 am – 4:30 pm. Anyone requesting a copy of a fire report is required to fill out a "Freedom of Information Act Request Form." Availability of completed reports may depend on fire investigations or other circumstances.
