

HOW TO READ YOUR METER

All customers within the City of New Baltimore have their water use measured by a meter. This result in each customer paying their share of operating the system based upon the amount of water used.

Nothing is better in the summer than a beautiful yard. However, it is important to keep in mind that the more water you use, the higher your water bill will be. One way that you can keep an eye on your water usage is to read your meter regularly.

Locate Your Meter

Water meters is generally located in the basement of your home or place of business in a direct line with the main outside faucet. In some cases with older homes they can be found in utility rooms, closets, behind/under stairways and in a crawl space.

Read Your Water Meter

Most of the homes have a digital meter. You will need a flash light to read this type of meter. There is a symbol of a flashlight in the lower left corner of the meter you will need to shine the light directly into it there are 8 digits. Read the meter left to right like diagram. In the example below the usage would be 51 thousand gallons.

KEEP TRACK

Of your reads monthly, note it on a calendar. This way you will see the usage of water you are using on a monthly basis. If you have any questions please feel free to contract the City.
