

Curbside Recycling Guidelines

TELEPHONE BOOKS

- Must be placed in the recycle bin or with Newspaper.

GLOSSY MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

- Bundle several at a time with string or strong rubber band
- Stuff as many as you can in a boxboard box and place in or on top of recycle bin for collection

BOXBOARD

- Cereal Boxes, shoe boxes, and similar type material.
- Stuff as many at a time in a boxboard box or brown paper bag and place in or on top of recycle bin
NO FROZEN FOOD BOXES (WAX COATED)

NEWSPAPER & GLOSSY INSERTS

- Place in brown paper bag or tuck to one side of recycling bin

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Fold or cut and place in separate brown paper bag or bundle in 2 foot by 2 foot wide bundles
- Place next to recycle bin

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

- Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars ONLY
- Rinse and TAKE LIDS OFF
- Labels are OK
- No ceramics, window glass, broken glass or drinking glasses. Bottles and jars only

PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS



- Look on the bottom for a 1-7 in chasing arrows
- Rinse and throw lids in trash - Labels are OK

METAL CANS

- Tin, steel and aluminum cans
- Lid OFF and place inside of the can
- Rinse, labels are OK

Curbside Recycling Guidelines

LATEX PAINT

- Fill the can with kitty litter
- Leave the lid off the can(s) and allow paint to dry
- Cans will be picked up at the curb only after the paint is dry

EMPTY AEROSOL CANS

- Must be empty
- Remove plastic lid and nozzle if possible

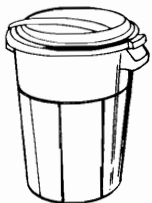

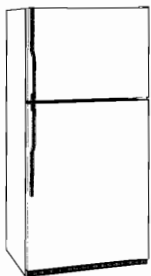
Pick-Up Schedule

Your pick-ups will generally fall around the same time each **WEDNESDAY**. However, due to traffic, road conditions and volumes we may sometimes run at a different time. To ensure pick up, please have your items at the curb **by 6:00 am. or the night before your collection day.**



Place rubbish in **CANS NO LARGER THAN 32-GALLONS, with lids or tied plastic bags WEIGHING NO MORE THAN 50 POUNDS EACH.**

Bulk Items



Large items such as furniture, appliances (including refrigeration units **WITHOUT** Freon), stove, hot water tank, grills, etc. will be collected on the same day with your rubbish. Carpet is accepted. It must be rolled and tied in 4 foot sections. No more than 16 bundles at any one time. Place at the curb with your rubbish by 6:00 a.m. or the night before.

CALL AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO TRASH DAY FOR LARGE ITEM COLLECTION. PLACE AT THE CURB ON COLLECTION DAY.

Please remove any doors from items before placing at the curb (for the safety of children playing near by). **Resident must have the Freon removed by a certified Technician.**

Holiday Schedule

ONLY IF THE HOLIDAY FALLS ON A MONDAY OR TUESDAY, YOUR COLLECTION DAY FALLS ONE DAY BEHIND.

Holidays Observed:

New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Items We Do NOT Collect

- Gasoline and Automotive Oil
- Car and Truck Parts/Engines
- Hazardous Wastes
- Yard Waste Mixed with Trash
- Concrete/Bricks
- Cyclone Fencing/Railroad Ties
- Tree Stumps

Yard Waste Collection

Yard Waste Is: Grass Clippings, Leaves, Shrubs & Brush Trimmings (under 4 inches in diameter)

Yard Waste DOES NOT Include: sod, pet waste, branches over 4 inches in diameter, dirt, rocks, trash, root balls.

Yard Waste Collection is from April 1st to November 30th

Place yard waste at the curb, Ten (10) feet from your rubbish in the following manner:

1. Place yard waste in 20 to 32 gallon cans **CLEARLY MARKED "YARD WASTE"**. Face Sticker Towards the Street, so the driver can identify the can as yard waste. Do not use a plastic bag liner. **Cans over 32-gallons will not be collected due to weight. No container should weigh more than 50 pounds.**
2. Place yard waste in designated paper yard waste bags available at local retail stores. Do not use paper grocery bags or boxes. No sticker is required. Please do not place rubbish in paper bags.
3. Bundle brush and branches that are 4 inches in diameter or less in 3 - 4 foot long bundles tied with string. Please insure bundles are no larger than 18 inches around.

YARD WASTE MIXED WITH RUBBISH CAN NOT BE COLLECTED.
