Festival Park Asphalt Milling Bids

- This project was originally bid on 7-13-22, however since only one bid was received, it was unopened, and the project rebid.
- On August 16, 2022 another bid opening was held. Again, only one bid was received-James P Contracting, in the amount of \$100,600.50.
- See attached recommended budget in the amount of \$149,315.50
- Recommendation of award to James P Contracting.

Road Maintenance Project

- PCE presented a Change Order for the following work modifications:
 1. Replace 102 LF deteriorated culvert under Avondale = add \$13,340.40
 2. Redesign curb/drainage on Lytton Street = deduct \$12,505.00
 3. Net result Change Order # 1 = +\$835.40
- Recommendation for approval of Change Order #1

Crack Filling:
