**RESOLUTION EXTENDING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY INCLUDING  
TEMPORARILY CLOSING BUILDINGS, RESTRICTING OPERATIONS OF THE  
CITY OF NEW BALTIMORE AND GRANTING EMERGENCY AUTHORITY TO THE  
MAYOR IN CONSULTATION WITH THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT  
COORDINATOR TO TAKE OTHER EMERGENCY MEASURES AS A RESULT  
OF COVID19 A/K/A CORONAVIRUS EPIDEMIC**

At the regular meeting of the City Council for the City of New Baltimore held in the Council Chambers at 36535 Green Street, City of New Baltimore, Macomb County, Michigan, 48047, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020, commencing at 7:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, recently a virus-related disease referred to as COVID19, also known as, the Coronavirus, has been reported with documented cases throughout the world, including the State of Michigan and Macomb County; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Michigan commencing Thursday, March 12, 2020, with Executive Order 2 has issued Executive Orders 2-8 relating to the subject including closing all K-12 schools, numerous colleges and universities restricting face-to-face instruction, closing places of assemblage, including bars and restaurants and otherwise seeking to drastically limit close proximity of members of the public with each other; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has the authority under the City of New Baltimore Ordinances and the Michigan Emergency Management Act, Section 10 of Public Act 390 of 1976, as

amended, to declare a local state of emergency and has issued such declaration March 17, 2020, which is subject to approval and extension by the City Council within seven (7) days of said declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion by Member Weinreich, supported by Member Szymanski, the City of New Baltimore local state of emergency issued by the Mayor on March 17, 2020 is hereby approved and extended for a period of ninety (90) days or until further action of the City Council;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that until April 27, 2020 at 11:59p.m., or less, if modified by action of the City Council, all buildings owned and/or operated by the City which are accessible to members of the public are hereby closed to the public and alternative means of doing City business will be provided;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that nonessential personnel and departments as determined by the Mayor will be directed to work from home or on a limited basis in the City offices to reduce contact with other employees;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council grants to the Mayor, in consultation with the Emergency Management Coordinator, the authority to take any other emergency measures as a result of the COVID19 a/k/a Coronavirus pandemic or other Executive Orders issued by the Governor of Michigan or the President of the United States.

Any resolutions in conflict are repealed only to the extent necessary to give full force and effect to the foregoing provisions.



This Resolution is deemed severable. Should any provision, clause, word or sentence be deemed unenforceable, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


