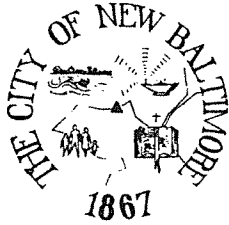
METER MUST BE INSTALLED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE PURCHASE DATE. Please call the Water Department @ 586-725-7300 after meter installation.

Meter location must be in an easily accessible location and in an area protected from freezing (NOT IN A CRAWL SPACE). Water sprinkling system MUST conform to all local plumbing and cross connection codes, complete with atmospheric vacuum breakers.

Billing information: The account will be activated the day the meter is purchased. Your sprinkler meter will be the same billing cycle/month as your home account. At this time you will receive 2 separate bills.

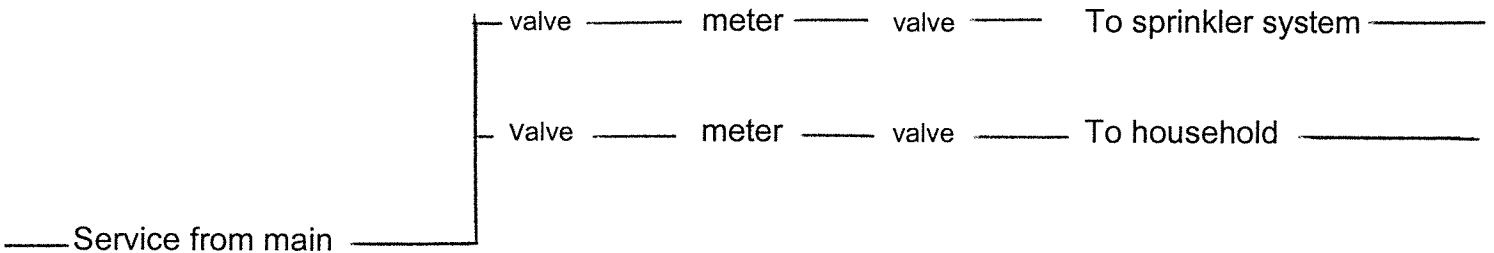


SPRINKLER METER INSTALLATION

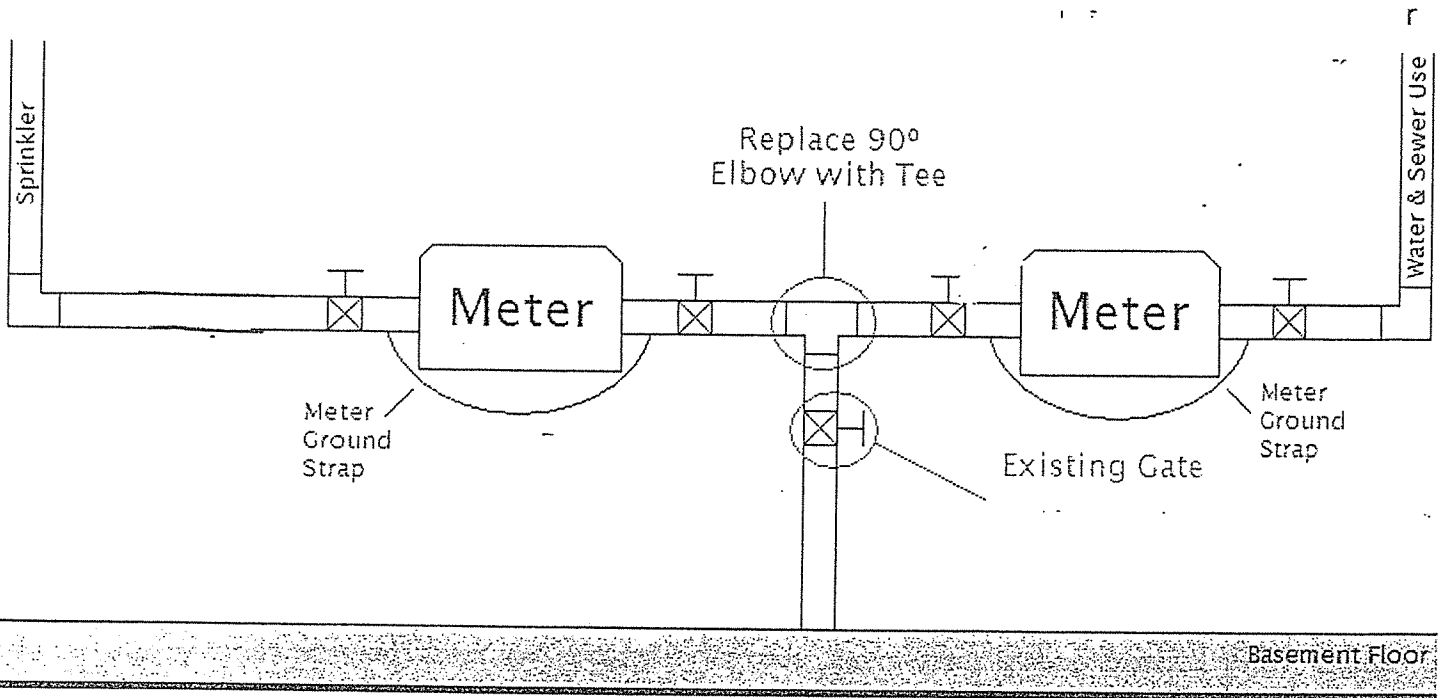
- Sprinkler systems must have an approved backflow prevention system
- The water service to the home must be separated from the sprinkler system to prevent the homeowner from paying twice for water usage
- Isolation valves must be installed before and after both the household meter and the sprinkler meter
- Water meters must be installed horizontally not vertically
- Water meters cannot be installed in a crawlspace. Any existing meters in a crawlspace must be moved to an easily accessible location.
- Inspections must be made by both the Water Department and the Plumbing Inspector. Inspections will be done separately
- Sewer credit will not be given until all inspections have been approved
- The homeowner is responsible for scheduling the Water Department inspection
- The homeowner or permit holder (if not the homeowner) is responsible for scheduling the plumbing inspection




Typical meter installation
