VI. NOTICE TO APPLICANT

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be undertaken until a Plumbing permit is issued. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected and approved.**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance of the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.**

- Each additional inspection requested for new construction requiring multiple inspections, due to work done in stages \$75.00

**Storm/sump installations can be installed by licensee or registered excavation contractors.

-NOTE- Water Meters shall be in the basement or on the first-floor level, meter shall not be located in crawl spaces. Water meters must be installed before final inspection request.

*****Residential New Construction**

1-Bathroom House – These fees include the underground inspection, provided that the underground inspection is done while inspecting the rough. If a separate underground inspection is required, add the above underground inspection.
