RESOLUTION

By the City Council:

WHEREAS, every year on April 28, communities and worksites around the world honor friends, family members, and colleagues who have been killed on the job; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics estimated that 4,64 workers were killed by traumatic injuries on the job. On average, more that 90 workers died every week, at roughly 13 workplace deaths a day, and

WHEREAS, in 2020, 131 workers were lost through fatal workplace accidents in Michigan; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor the memory of the courageous and dedicated members of Michigan's labor force who have been injured or disabled or have died as a result of workplace accidents; and

WHEREAS, we remember those who have died in workplace catastrophes, suffered occupational-related disease, or have been injured due to dangerous conditions; and

WHEREAS, Recognition of the integrity of Michigan's workforce and its achievements on behalf of the economic growth of our state is necessary; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of New Baltimore wishes to pay tribute to the workers who have died or been injured or disabled in workplace accidents. We honor the contributions of Michigan's workforce and call for increased workplace safety;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of New Baltimore renews our efforts to seek stronger workplace safety and health protections better standards and enforcement, and fair and just compensation; and try rededicating ourselves to improving safety and health in every city workplace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of New Baltimore, that the members of this legislative body declare April 28, 2022 as
