



Who We Are

The NBACC is the resident-led arts advisory commission to the City of New Baltimore. Composed of nine citizen commissioners, the group is charged with fostering the growth and development of arts and community in the **visual, literary, musical, culinary, and performing arts.**

Visual Arts: *painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, photography, video, filmmaking, comics, design, crafts, architecture, horticulture.*

Literary Arts: *writing, speaking, poetry*

Musical Arts: *musical performance*

Culinary Arts: *cooking, baking, plating, presentation, and service of food, gastronomy*

Performing Arts: *music, dance, theater, opera, acting, singing, and spoken word poetry*

What We Do

Together, the commission creates pathways for projects in each of these artistic areas; selecting & identifying artists, creating lists & groups of art participants, identifying locations of public art, identifying potential projects & events, raising funds, creating recommended budgets for projects, managing volunteers, and taking general action to encourage participation and interaction with the arts, in addition to creating plans for the maintenance of public art. All recommendations are made to the New Baltimore City Council for consideration and/or approval.
